Judge G. A. Hale has been sick, but is improving. Fresh pickles ten cents per quart at Gaston's.

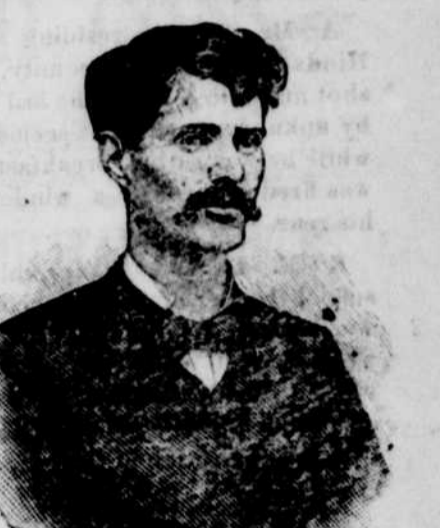
