the outstanding spring businesses for Kennewick, with several hatcheries functioning on large scales. The biggest business will be from now until about June 1 when hatching starts slacking off. The chicks hatched now will become broilers in a few weeks and many of these will go to the butcher's market. Pullets raised for laying will start producing eggs about August 1.

Benton county poultry producers were advised this week to take a look at their brooders to see how their baby chicks are standing the weather. While the big hatcheries have adequate facilities to raise their chicks without fear of harm from cold weather, the small producer often finds cool weather a handicap. County Agent Webster says that producers should take time to watch their birds. If they are huddled and crowded underneath the hover and chirping loudly, they're probably too cold. On the other hand, if the birds

are too hot, they,re probably staying away from the brooder. Chicks that are comfortable are

naturally quiet, and when bedded down at night, stay right around the edge of the brooder.

And what if the chicks are too hot or too cold? Dr. Wilson Henderson. Diagnostic veterinarian, Western Washington Experiment Station, has these suggestions to offer.
