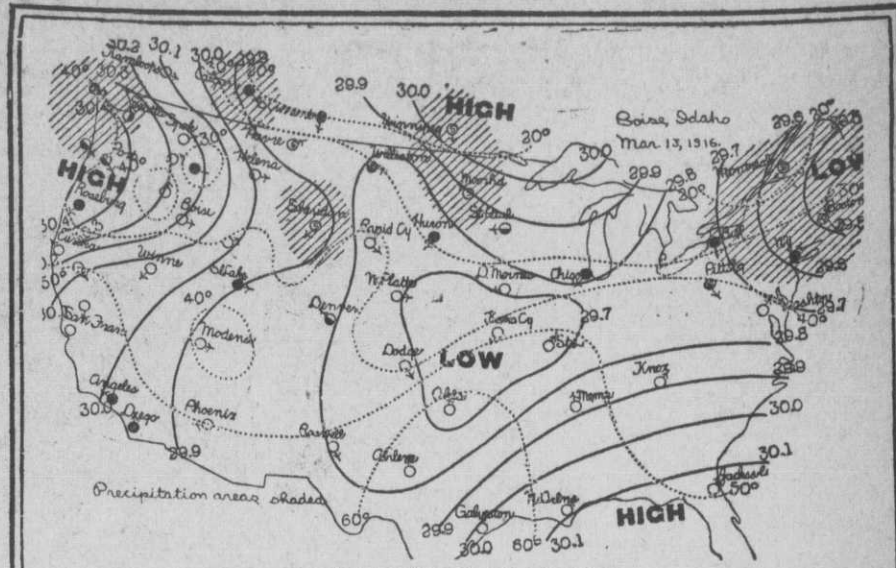

FORECAST FOR BOISE AND VICINITY—Fair tonight and Tuesday.
DAILY REPT—Highest temperature yesterday, 59; lowest temperature this morning, 30; mean temperature yesterday, 54.

CONDITIONS—High atmospheric pressure prevails on the north and middle Pacific slope, in the Gulf and south Atlantic states, and north of Minnesota. Elsewhere the pressure is

low, the points of greatest depression being on the New England coast, and in Missouri respectively. Precipitation has been light and scattering. Mild weather prevails except in the extreme north, the highest temperature being in the southern plains states. Fair weather is expected to continue in Boise and its vicinity tonight and Tuesday.
