The emperor of Austris will ar rive in England about the end of dugust，and it is expected that he will spend three weeks deer stalk． ing in the Highlande as the guost of the queen．It will be his first visi to Great Britain．
Twenty－five houses tave been des troyed and fifty－nine badly damaged by the sioking of the earth at Brues Bobemia．Nearly twenty five hun－ dred persons have been turned out of their homes，for it is feared that other houses will collapse．
It is officially anoounced tha Queen Victoria has approved the ap pointment of General Lord Roberis to the command of hier majesty＇ forces in Ireland．The Earl o Cadogan，the new Viceroy of Ire． land，made his state entry into Dublin on Angust 2.
A despatch trom Tangiers report that the stuation viear Saifi，Mo－ roco，where a German nimed Rock－ strop wâs murdered，is extremely critical．The town is besieged by rebellious Bedonin tribes．Some rebels tried to escape from prison． A fight ensued and several were killed．The governor has distribs－ ted rifles among the Earopean resi－ dents．
The pope has addressed an ency－ clical letter to the bishops of Bel－ gium，urging them te aim at amelio－ rating the strained relations exist ing in that conorry between capital and labor by conciliating the res－ pective intereets．The pope con－ clades his letter by calling on Cath． olics to oppose strenuously the per verse theories of socialism，whicl，he says，directs all its efforts against religion．
The London Times prints a Hav－ ana despatch saying that according to information from insurgent sour－ ces，General Campos＇force was destroyed in the battle near Bayamo． General Campos and a half dozen others of his best mounted officers alone escaped．General Campos was wounded．The roport of the capture of Antonio Maceo，the insur－ gent chief，according to the same anthority，is not true
