NO DAMAGE DONE TO CANE

The frost of last night added greatly to the value of standing sugar cane. The freeze of last night was light and reports from experienced sugar men are to the effect that the cold snap of the past two days and nights has been more beneficial than detrimental to the cane.

Not all sugar men, however, agree that the cold weather has benefitted the cane. Mr. Percy O'Brien, a well-known planter of Rhoda, says that, while the cane has not been damaged by the freeze he can not conceive of any benefit it, has been. It is his opinion that the cane has ripened well this year and that a freeze to stop the growth is not necessary. Mr. O'Brien states after a careful examination he has failed to find a single dead bud on the stalks.

Mr. P. U. Bernuchio of Avoca is of the opinion that the cold weather has not damaged the cane crops and that the cane this year is unusually fine and of excellent quality at this time.
