RAILROAD RATES

MUST BE ADJUSTED

In an address on "The Railroad Pus zle," delivered in Philadelphia, January 3, Dr. Emory R. Johnson, dean of the Wharton School of Finance, and one of the nation's leading authorities on railroad transportation, declared that "after the first of March the compatries must be self-supporting or become bankrapt." Continuing, he said:

"If the carriers avoid failure their income must cover operating expenses, maintenance and capital charges; if the companies succeed to the extent that is demanded in public interest, they must not only be able to meet unavoidable expenses, they must have

part for betterments and in part for building up a surplus or reserve fund, the public will not invest in the railronds, their credit cannot be re-established and maintained and corporate ownership and operation of the rail-

"The income of the carriers is determined by public regulation, and properly so; but from this it follows that the country must decide between a policy of adequate revenues to the railroad corporations of the future and a policy of government ownership.

"The government is entitled to credit for having given greater unity to rail-road operation, both line and terminal. It has done much that the carriers were prohibited from doing. The public now realize that co-operation of the carriers in the joint use of equip-ment and terminals should be encouraged, instead of prevented.
"The railroad legislation now pend-

ing in Congress must solve many difficult questions, but the most critical one is that of providing for the future regniation of railroads in accordance with a policy that will cause the carriers to secure revenue sufficient to enable them to perform their services adequately and with progressive efficiency.
