The Power plant here has bought a large amount of oil from the Anse-la-Butte field. The saving in the cost of transportation will be about seventy-five per cent. and this saving will soon pay for the boat and the management will be saved a great deal of trouble and anxiety in not having to depend on the unreliable and irregular rail-road transportation.
