For Spokane land at Spokane, Wash.





Buying Coal Now.

The railway managers are again asking that shipments of coal be made early so that there may be no shortage in case of bad weather, etc, to avoid a rush later. This is a good idea, but it is of no use to ask the consumer to lay in a store of coal at this early date. It may be very desirable for him to do so, even from his own standpoint, but he simply won't do it unless in exceptional cases.

The circular recently issued to the agents by the N. P. is to dealers and it is up to them to look after this matter, but primarily it is up to the big coal companies. The circular states that the "wholesale companies are now prepared to fill all orders for immediate shipment." We do not see why those same coal piles now on the docks at Duluth can not be distributed by the wholesale people among the local dealers of the northwest at once.

Nearly all the local dealers would be willing to accept shipments to certain amounts now, provided they did not have to pay until about the same time as they would if ordered in the ordinary way.

As it is, it looks as if the wholesale people wanted the consumer to buy his coal now and pay for it in the pretty soon—which would be of obvious advantage to the wholesale people, and of no advantage to the local dealer or to the consumer—unless he is scared.
