The Milk Quarton,—The New York Ledger, says:

The City Inspector, in his last annual report, states that the number of deaths in this city during the last year was 21.645, of which number 12.948 were children. He also says that a large may-rity of these deaths of children are traceable directly, or indirectly, to the use of that slow poison usually called swill milk. The City Inspector's description of this "milk." and of the wretched animals from which it is wrung, is enough to make any mother's hair stand on end. This is the season of the year when this poisonous milk is most fital to children, and it is positive infanticide knowingly to lead them upon it. The seeds of death lark in every drop of it during these swellering days; and every mother should, therefore, see to it, that her children are protected against the deadly beverage. Fure water is better for them than poisoned milk.

COTTON BILLS RETURNED .- The New York Herald, of the 28th, says :

Romors are affoat to-day that a large amount of cotton bills have been returned from Liverpool, advices to that effect having probably been talegraphed from Halifax. We hear of £75 000 of bills coming back to one house. Nothing authentic is known, however, on the subject; the livers in such cases generally keep the facts to themselves. It is probable that the bills will prove to have been drawn on the houses of Rickarby or H. & D. Cobroigh, whose failures we noticed a few days since. No fresh failures are reported from Liverpool; but the late decline in cetton will rice to some heavy reclamations from the other side.
