Railway Labor Board Hands Down Decision Increasing Wages

80,000 WORKMEN TO BE AFFECTED

Award Retroactive to May 1; Will Add 16 Cents Hour Average to Scale

CHICAGO, III. AUE. 18.—The railway lahor board today handed down a decision indreasing wages of employes of the American Railway Express company 150,000,000 yearly. Eighty thousand mue not provided for by the recent 1500,000,000 railway waga ward are affected.

The award is retreactive to May 1, 1920. The wage increase, amousting to 15 cents an hour, will give massengers and other train service employes an increase of \$12.00 a month All other employes will receive an increase of \$12.00 a work on a 200 hour hostis. Train service employes work on a 200 hour month basis, while all other employes work on a 200 hour hostis. Under the terms of the Each-Camming transportation sot, the express company will be permitted to raise its rates sufficiently to meet the increased labor cost. Arguments in the rate case already have been presented before the intervals commerce commission at Washington.

The express decision applies to all express employes, with the exception of 1200 shopmen, who were given a 11 cents an hour award is slightly better than the averaged increase to the railroad men, the board finding that express employes, as a class, were not so well paid as men in other lines of railroad work.
