

**SHOW PARADE MONDAY, WHEN GENTRYS COME**

Monday is "circus day." It is the occasion of the appearance here of the "Gentry Brothers" show and wild animal arena. The parade will start from the show grounds promptly at noon and pass through the principal streets.

This is the first tented show of the season to visit El Paso. Frank M. Swan, press agent, says all of the men, women and children connected with the show will take some part in the parade and a hundred ponies will be in line.

Every cage will be open, except in a few instances where climate conditions are prohibitory, he says.

Bands of music and a colony of clowns will add to the gaiety of the parade. He says the show has been enlarged since its last visit to El Paso and now has three rings and employs over 250 people.

**Secrets Of The Movies Revealed**

Each individual picture remains on the screen one thirty-second of a second, followed by a period of darkness of almost equal duration, created by the shutter passing before the front of the lens before the next picture is flashed on the screen. The impression of the picture remains on the brain one twenty-fourth of a second after the picture disappears, and although the impression still remains when the next picture appears, the latter being a brighter image will cause the former to merge into the image of the second picture. series of snapshots depicting motion.
