

Were Chased Across the Desert by Chinese-Thousands Massacred. TROITZKOSAWSK, Transbikalia, Siberia, Aug. 3.-Seven American missionaries from Peking with their families have arrived here. They escaped from Peking and were chased across the sand and mountains of the Gobi desert for 400 miles, suffering fearful tortures
