WILL NOT RECOMMEND ANY STOCK INVESTMENTS

No Investment Securities Guaranteed
by "Blue Sky" Board, Says
Mr. Schultz.

To safeguard the inexperienced in-
vestor in securities offered by any
agent, even though he may have a li-
cense, the state "Blue Sky" commis-
sion announces that it will not rec-
ommend any investment offered.

In this connection the commission
has caused to be printed on the li-
cense issued to all agents the follow-
ing warning which should be noted
by persons, who are asked to invest:
"The commission does not recom-
mend the purchase of securities of-
fered by this or any other agent."

It is believed that this clause on the
agent's license will prevent unscrup-
ulous dealers in stocks or other in-
vestment securities from attempting
to mislead persons into the belief
that that particular investment has
the approval of the commission.
"Every effort is being made to pro-
tect the investor," said Clifford G.
Schultz, Secretary of the commission,
"and the commission will be glad to
hear of any complaint against agents
or others in which they have intimat-
ed that the commission approves any
particular investment."
