In an address at the democratic banquet at St. Paul on June 1, 1911, Joseph W. Folk defined his idea of democracy in these words:

"Democracy is a religion; the religion of brotherhood among men and of equal rights for all. It is a religion that would demand more of the Golden Rule government and in our daily lives. It would not array class against class, but would protect the rights better now. of all by having each respect the rights of the other. It would not attack weathh honestly acquired, but would wage unending war against the priveleges that produce tainted riches on one side, and undeserved poverty on the other side.
