#### TRAINING OF DISABLED SOLDIERS AND SAILORS.

In order to take training under the Board, a soldier, sailor marine or nurse must have resigned or have been discharged from the military service under honorable conditions since April 7, 1917, and must have been so disabled that vocational education is necessary to overcome the handicap of his disability.

In the restraining of the injured soldiers the Federal Board makes use of all the educational institutions, both institutions, both public and private, that provide courses suitable to its needs. It also makes use of factories, shops, stores, Navy Yards, banks, commercial institutions, etc., which provide courses that may be needed in particular cases. In each instance contracts are made with the institutions by which the Board is permitted to supervise the course of instruction given. The Board pays the expense of tuition, books, appliances, etc., and make an allowance of not more than \$80. per month for subsistence to a single man and \$115 per month to a married man without children. Additional allowances are made for each dependent child.

Application should be made to the District vocational officer, Federal Board for Vocational Education, 810 Western Indemnity Bldg., Dallas, Texas, who will give each case careful consideration and advise what steps to take to secure training by this Board should he be eligible therefor.

#### WANTS PROFITS KNOWN

##### McAdoo Says Tax Returns Can Show Mine Owners' Receipts.

New York, Nov. 25.—A showdown on profits made by bituminous operators is needed for the American people to form a just opinion on the coal situation, William G. McAdoo, former secretary of the treasury, declared today.

Mr. McAdoo's statement was made after he had been read an Associated Press dispatch from Washington giving the substance of an open telegram addressed to him by the operators, criticising him for "injecting" himself into the wage controversy. Mr. McAdoo had not received the telegram.

"The question is whether or not the coal operators are making excessive profits," said his statement. "Their income tax returns filed under oath will give an understanding of the truth and facts. If they are making excessive profits, as they were clearly making in 1917, then any increase of wages that may be made to the miners should not be passed on to the public in the form of increased prices for bituminous coal. A showdown will enable the American people to form a just opinion."

#### REFUGEES OF RANK AIDED

Salonica, Greece.—The most distinguished group of refugees that has come to the attention of the American Red Cross at Salonica has been given aid and sent on its way.

It consisted of two Admirals of the Russian navy, two Lieutenant-Generals, several Brigadier-Generals, many Colonels, Captains, Lieutenants and a Governor-General and a Senator from one of the South Russia provinces. They had been driven from Russia by the revolutionists and had managed to reach Salonica. They arrived here penniless and without baggage, carrying on their backs their remaining possessions.

#### LULLABIES FOR SOLDIERS

Lullabies for soldiers whose minds are sick! It's a new idea, one of the many schemes hatched by Red Cross musical directors at military hospitals in this country, who are trying to bring men back to themselves through the medium of melody. At Fort Sam Houston, Tex., an accomplished woman pianist, with a trio (piano, violin and cello), plays three times a week at bed time or after the mental patients have retired, with the object of quieting the men or putting them to sleep.

#### HERE IS A REAL EXPLANATION OF SUGAR SHORTAGE

Washington, Nov. 23.—Enough sugar to relieve the present famine is hidden in the mountains of East Tennessee, Georgia, Alabama and North Carolina, where it is being used in the distillation of illicit whiskey, according to internal revenue officers at work in these districts.

Two deputy collectors, T. B. Irvine and W. T. Crew operating in the mountains east of Chattanooga, recently confiscated more than 1,000 pounds of granulated sugar from the still in the Smoky mountains.

The deputies explain that it requires 10 pounds of sugar to make one gallon of whiskey under the moonshiners' recipe of manufacture.

#### SUGAR STOCK LIBELED

##### Federal Official Charges It Is Hoarded For Higher Prices

St. Louis, Nov. 23.—A libel was issued yesterday by Assistant United States District Attorney Wheeler for 2,284 sacks of sugar, each containing 100 pounds, which is alleged to be held by a cold storage company for a local manufacturer and wholesaler of fruit preserves, syrups and soda water.

Wheeler holds in his libel proceedings that the amount is in excess of that which could be legitimately used for manufacturing purposes and that it is being held for a higher market.
