How Does Sap Run in Pine Trees? To the Editor of Scientific American: In about ninety per cent of all pine trees in this section, the fiber of the sap wood runs in a spiral
around the tree contrary to the moton of the hands of a clock, i. e from left to right in ascending the tree. This fact is easily observable
in trees that have died, and from which the bark has fallen. Dyclones in the northern hemisphere revolve contrary to clock-hand motion. Probably the cause is the same in both cases; liquid sap mowing like cyclones. It would there-
fore be interesting to learn whether fore be interesting to learn whether
this fact in regard to pines is universal throughout the northern hemisphere; and in order to deter-
