An Immense Crowd Will Be in Jefferson City May 21—Arrangements Being Made.

Thursday, May 21, will be a great day for Jefferson City. It will be the dedication of her great steel bridge across the Missouri river, and the event promises to bring together the biggest crowd of people that ever assembled at the capital of Missouri.

The program has not been completed in all details yet, but it has progressed far enough to show that it will be very attractive, and that the visitors to Jefferson City will be fully entertained.
