Polities and Inflation.

Unless Germany collapses before August. Roosevelt will be re-nominated and probably re-elected. It looks now as if Willkie would be nominated at the Republican leaders believe Roosevelt has the election in the bag. This would be a good way of getting rid of Willkie forever. Another possibility is that Willkie may accept second place on the Democratic ticket. The Republicans will put their efforts upon Congress. In November. 1944, they should secure a good majority of the House and six more senators. When I look further ahead. 1948 seems now like a good Republican year with Governor Dewey the victor, in case Willkie is not already President.
