IS A FINE OPENING

Opportunity Democrats Have to Elect Aldermen This Spring.

PRESENT ADMINISTRATION IS WEAK

Should Nominate Good Men at Caucuses Tomorrow Evening.

The desirability of clean politics coupled with the need for the election of new aldermen afforded by the weakness of the present administration gives the democratic party an opportunity for success this spring such as it never had before.

The present administration, in both branches of municipal government, legislative and executive, is the weakest unquestionably ever known in the city's history.

Republicans as well as democrats agree the city would fare better if both parties were represented instead of having one entirely dominant in the council, as is now the case.
