PAY MORE TAXES

Rate Increased in City of Rock Island From \$7.69 to \$8.44 in 1904.

COUNTY TO RAISE \$680,971.52

Total Valuation of all Property is Placed at \$9,527,536—By Townships.

Rock Island county will raise in taxes on the levy of 1904, collectible this year, a total of \$680,971.52, on a valuation of all properties, embracing real estate, personal, railroads, telephone and telegraph, of \$9,527,536.

The county levy remains unchanged but there is an increase in the state rate of 3 cents. This year it is 55 against 52 the preceding levy. There is noted a raise in the rate in both Rock Island and Moline, due to greater demands for municipal and school purposes. In the city of Rock Island the 1904 levy shows a total valuation of \$2,150,092, a tax of \$266,819.72; for municipal \$91,692.25; for school, \$95,000; and the rate, \$8.44.

Spread on Township Books. The levy has been spread on the books of the township collectors by County Clerk H. B. Hubbard. The work has been under way for weeks, and was finished last evening. The total valuation of lands in the county is placed at \$2,235,729; of lots, \$2,970,080; of personal property, \$2,075,964, and the total, not including the railroads, telegraph and telephone, \$8,281,773.

Rock Island—Lands, \$1,146,680; lots, \$1,459,031; personal, \$44,190; total, \$2,649,901. Tax, \$215,539.78.

South Rock Island—Lands, \$125,290; lots, \$36,632; personal, \$37,003; total, \$198,925. Tax, \$16,045.99.

Black Hawk—Lands, \$141,237; lots, \$22,937; personal, \$29,186; total, \$193,360. Tax, \$9,928.37.
