Tall Students Form Novel Club  
With Six Feet Three Min-  
imum Height.

## TALLEST MAN PRESIDENT

University of Missouri Boys Number-  
ing Eight Will Give Dance for  
Shortest Coeds.

Eight of the students of the Uni-  
versity of Missouri at Columbia, Mo.,  
have formed a tall man's club. The  
only requirement for eligibility in the  
"Long Fellow" club is that each man  
must be 6 feet 3 inches tall.

The club was organized to have the  
low earnings of Columbia, the low  
doorways and the low chandeliers in  
public places elevated so that these  
men can pass under without striking  
their heads. They have gone through  
so long that some will have to exert a  
great effort to get their spines straight-  
ened once more. That is one of their  
rules that must be lived up to.

Has Lefty Honorary Members.  
The club has received the stamp of  
approval because Dr. A. Ross Hill,  
president of the University of Mis-  
souri, is an honorary member. Dr.  
Hill stands 6 feet 3 1/2 inches in his  
stocking feet. The club has the ap-  
proval of the church, because the Rev.  
Henry P. Horton, rector of Calvary  
Episcopal church, is also an honorary  
member. Mr. Horton is 6 feet 5 1/2  
inches tall. Berry McAlester, manager  
of the Boone County Lumber com-  
pany, and Robert W. Jones, a newspaper  
man, are also honorary members. Mr.  
McAlester is 6 feet 3 1/2 inches tall, and  
Mr. Jones is half an inch longer than  
Mr. McAlester.

President is Six Feet Six.  
The presidency of the club goes with-  
out election to the tallest man. Just  
now this honor is held by R. A. Adams  
of Columbia. He is 6 feet 6 inches  
tall. V. E. D. Landon, a law student  
of Marshall, Mo., is second in height—  
6 feet 5 1/2 inches. G. W. Sneed, Co-  
lumbia, 6 feet 5 inches; A. W. Roberts,  
Auxvasse, Mo., 6 feet 4 1/2 inches; Ray  
Dumlap, Mexico, Mo., 6 feet 3 1/2 inches;  
W. H. Macley, Tipton, 6 feet 4 inches;  
S. D. Perkins, 1107 Pennsylvania ave-  
nue, Kansas City, 6 feet 3 1/2 inches,  
and H. W. Pitcher, Joplin, 6 feet 3 1/2  
inches, are members.

The club has planned a dance for  
each semester of the school year. The  
first dance will be held in a short  
time, and the members are instructed  
to invite young women who are at  
least 5 feet 10 inches tall. The second  
dance of the year each man will be in-  
structed to bring the shortest co-ed  
possible.

## BIG PRIVATE AUDITORIUM.

Stocks Does Not Believe in Opera and  
Aids a Choral Union.

Carl Stockel, patron of the Litchfield  
County Choral Union, in Connecticut,  
comprising five societies, with a mem-  
bership of 600, is having the largest  
private auditorium in America built on  
his premises in Norfolk, Conn. His  
hobby is to give the people of Litch-  
field county a fine musical education.

It is said he expends about \$10,000 an-  
nually in the work. Mr. Stockel says:  
"The nearest gateway to divinity is  
by the road of truth in art. We shall  
not find truth if we look about the  
pastboard scenery, the tinsel and the  
trappings of the operatic stage, so feebly  
exploited by commercial managers as  
educational and even consensual."

such end our organization is committed.  
It is blazing a narrow path which

quiem mass and Coleridge Taylor's  
Indian music in Mr. Stockel's audi-  
torium June 1 and 2. Coleridge Taylor  
has accepted an invitation to come  
from Europe to conduct his own com-  
position.

Fishing For Squirrels.  
A unique method with which to cap-  
ture squirrels was successfully demon-  
strated at Farmington, Md., when  
William J. Reynolds recently caught  
four with hook and line. Reynolds  
saw several enter a hole in a tree  
about thirty feet from the ground. He  
procured a hook and, climbing to a  
high limb, lowered the fishing tackle  
into the hole. Finally the hook caught
