ORDINANCE No. 1.

An ordinance prescribing the manner of introduction of ordinances and resolutions, providing for the reading and passing of the same; for the taking of the ayes and noes; for the signing by the president; for the certification by the clerk; and for the publication of the same.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Imperial do ordain as follows.

Section 1. That no ordinance or resolution shall be passed by the said Board except in conformity to the provisions of this Ordinance hereinafter ex-

SEC. 2. All ordinances and resolutions shall be presented to the said Board in writing.

SEC. 3. All ordinances shall be read upon the day of presentation to said Board and shall then pass to second reading upon the vote of said Board. The said ordinance shall then be read a third time before passage by said Board, provided that by unanimous consent of the members of said Board present the second and third readings of any ordinance may be dispensed with and said ordinance and resolution passed

SEC. 4. No ordinance and no resolution granting a franchise for any pur-pose shall be passed by the said Board on the day of its introduction, nor within five days thereafter, nor at any other than a regular meeting.

SEC. 5. No resolution or order for the payment of money shall be passed at any other time than at a regular meet-

SEC. 6. No ordinance, resolution or order shall have any validity or effect unless passed by the votes of at least three members of said board.

SEC. 7. The ayes and noes on all ordinances, resolutions or orders shall be taken on the passage of said ordinances, resolutions or orders, and recorded in the minutes of the said meeting.

SEC. 8. All ordinances, resolutions or orders shall be signed by the president of said Board upon the passage thereof.

SEC. 9. No ordinance or resolution granting any franchise shall have any validity until the same shall have been certified by the City Clerk and shall have been published at least once in a newspaper published within the limits

of said city of Imperial.

SEC. 10. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this Ordinance and cause same to be published once in The Imperial Press, a weekly paper published in said city of Imperial, and thereupon and thereafter it shall take effect and be in full force.
