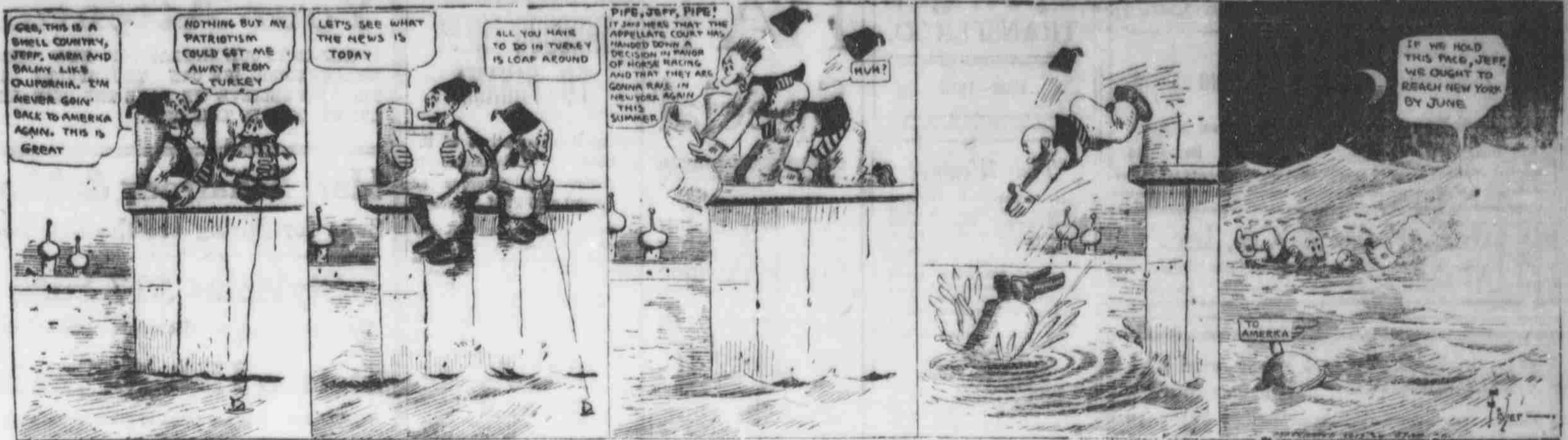

Certificate of Amendment to Articles of Incorporation of Rosendall Brothers, a Corporation.

We, the undersigned, president and secretary of Rosendall Brothers, a corporation, do hereby certify pursuant to the provisions of Sec. 20, Chap. 79, of the Laws of the Territory of New Mexico for the year 1902, that at a regular meeting of the board of directors of said corporation held at the office of said company on the 10th day of January, 1913, the following resolution was adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED, that a change and alteration in the Articles of Incorporation of this company increasing its capital stock from Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$16,000.00) to Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) and permitting the executive committee provided for in subdivision (c) of Article VII to consist of one or more members is advisable.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that a meeting of the stockholders of this company to take action on this resolution be, and it is hereby called to meet at the office of the company on the 25th day of January, 1913. AND we further certify that pursuant to the foregoing resolution a meeting of the stockholders of Rosendall Brothers, a corporation, was held at the office of said company on the 25th day of January, 1913, at which all the stockholders were present and that at said meeting the following resolutions were unanimously adopted, all the stockholders of said company voting in favor thereof, to wit:

BE IT RESOLVED that the capital stock of this corporation be increased from Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$16,000.00) to Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) and that Article 4 of the Articles of Incorporation of this corporation be, and it is hereby changed and amended to read as follows:

ART. 4. The total authorized capital stock of this corporation is Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) divided into twenty-five hundred (2500) shares of the par value of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) each. This corporation heretofore accords the provisions of the Constitution of the State of New Mexico governing corporations and agrees to be bound thereby.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that subdivision "c" of Article VII of said articles of incorporation be amended to read as follows: "To create by resolution one or more executive committees each to consist of one or more directors and to authorize each committee so created for the time being to have and exercise any or all of the powers of the board of directors which may be lawfully delegated."

AND we do further certify that the principal place of business and office of said corporation in the state of New Mexico is at the corner of Fourth and Central avenues in the city of Albuquerque, and the name of the agent therein and in charge thereof upon whom process against the corporation may be served is David S. Rosenwald.

AND we do further certify for and on behalf of said corporation in accordance with the requirements of Sec. 12 of Art. XI of the Constitution of the State of New Mexico that the corporation has accepted and does hereby accept all of the provisions of said constitution.
