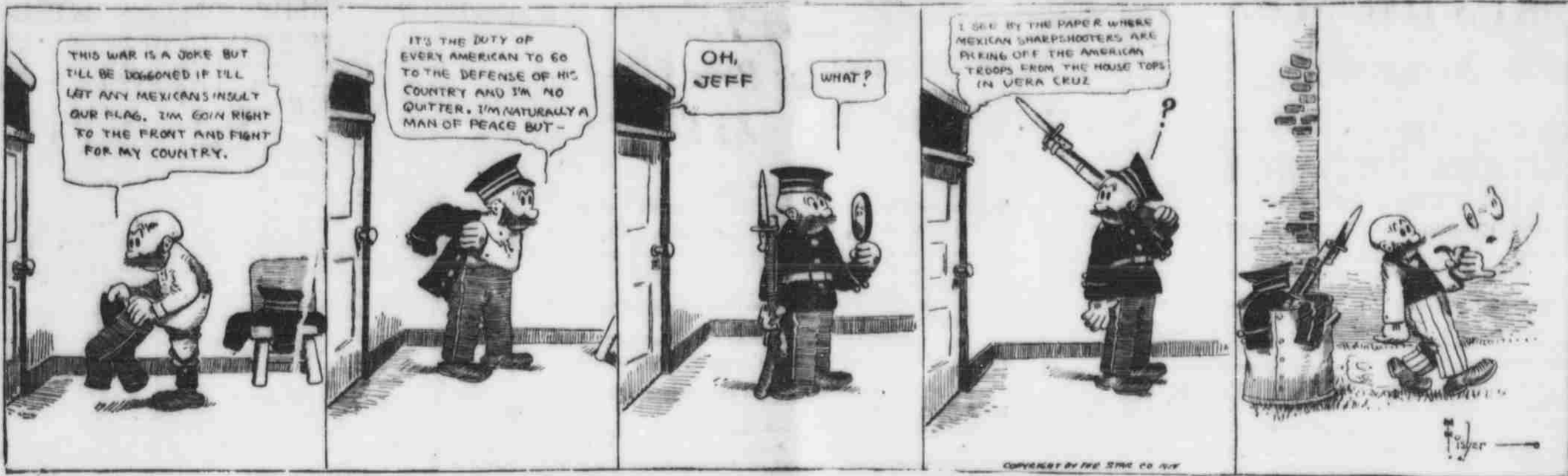

Prices started 1-8c to 2-8c 1/2c higher, but afterward reacted. Later a decided sag occurred owing to predictions that the government crop report would show a higher condition May 1 than a month previous, notably in western Kansas, Nebraska and Oklahoma.
