Proclamation by the Governor—\$200 Reward.

Whereas, official information has been received at this Department that Simon Atkins was murdered on the 14th day of November last, in the county of Wake. And, whereas, it appears that the party or parties who committed the said offense are UNKNOWN. Now, therefore, I, Thomas M. Holt, Governor of the State of North Carolina, by virtue of the authority in me vested by law, do issue this, my Proclamation, offering a reward of

TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS,

for the arrest and delivery to the Sheriff of Wake county, at the Court House in Raleigh, of the person or persons who committed said murder, to be paid upon the conviction of such person or persons of the crime charged against him or them. And I do enjoin all officers of the State and all good citizens to assist in bringing the criminals to justice.

Done in our city of Raleigh, this 7th day of January, Eighteen Hundred and Ninety two and in the One Hundred and Sixteenth year of our American Independence.
