FORM.

1. We recognize the equality of all men before the law, and hold that it is the duty or the government in its dealing, with the people to mete out equal and exact justice to all, of whatever nationality, race, color or persuasion, religous or political.

2. We pledge ourselves to maintain the union of the States, emancipation and enfranchisement, and to oppose any reopen; ng of the questions settled by the 13 th, 14th and 15th amendments.

3. We demand the immediate and absolute removal of all disabilities imposed on a count of the rebell.on withich was fully subdued seven years ago believing that universal amnesty will result in a complete pacification of all sec ions of the country.

4. Ineal self-government with impartial suffrage will guard the rights of all citizens more securely than any centralized power. The public welfare requires this supremacy of the civil over the military power, and freedom of per-on under the protection of the habeus corpus We demand for individuals the largest liberties consistent with public order; for States, se f gov. ernment, and for the nation, a return to the methods of peace and the constitutional limitation of power.

5 The civil service of the Govornment has become a mere instrument of partisan tyranny, and personal ambition, and an object of selfishness. It is a scandal and a reproach upon free institutions, and breathes a demoralization dangerous to the perpetuity of a Republican Government. We therefore regard a thorough reform of the civil service as one of the most pressing necessities of the hour; that honesty capaci y and fidelity constitute the only valid ciaim to public employment; that the offices of the government cease to be a marter of arbitrary favoritism and patronage and that a public station may again become a jost of honor. and it is imperatively required that no President shall be a candidate for reelection.

6. We demand a system of federal taxation which shall not unnecessarily interfere with the industries of the people, and which shall provide the means necessary to pay the expenses of the government economically administered, pensions, the interest on the public debt and a moderate reduction annually of the principle thereof. And recognizing that there are in our midst honest but irreconcilable difference of opinion with regard to the respective systems of protection and free trade. we remit the discussion of the subject to the people in their Congressional Districts and to the decision of Congress thereon, wholly free from Execu-

tive control or dictation. 7. The publ e credit must be sacre its maintained, and we denounce repudiation in every form.

8. A speedy return to specie pay ments is demanded alike by the highest consideration of commercial morality and honest government

9. We remember with gratitude the heroism and sacrifices of the soldiers and sailors of the Republic, and no act of ours shall ever detract from their justly-earned fame, or the full records of their patriotism.

10. We are opposed to further grant of lands to railroad or corporations. The public domain shall be held sacred to actual settlers.

11. We hold that it is the duty of the Government in its intercourse with foreign nations to cultivate their friendterms, regarding it alike dishonorable solicited. to demand what is not right or to submit to what is wrong.

12. For the promotion and success of these vital principles and the sup port of the candidates nominated by this Convention, we invite and cordially welcome the co-op ration of all patriotie citizen, without regard to previous poitical affiliations.
