DOGS.

Registration and License of Dogs

Every owner or keeper of a dog of the age of six months or over shall on or before the first of May, or at such time as such dog shall become six months old, and in each year thereafter, cause such dog to be registered, numbered, described and licensed until the first of May following in the Town Clerk's office in the town where such dog is owned or kept.

PENALTY

Every person owning, keeping or harboring a dog, who shall fail to comply with any provision of this chapter for which no other penalty is provided, shall be fined not more than seven dollars, or imprisoned not more than thirty days, or both.
