The maker of an "accommoda the accommodation of the holder) cratic party in the next primary elect- to the democratic primary election. is not bound to the person accommodated, but is bound to all parties, precisely as if there was a good consideration.

No consideration is sufficient in law if it be illegal in its nature.

Checks or drafts must be presented for payment without unreasonable delay.

Checks or drafts must be presented during business hours, but in this country, except in the case of the banks, the time extends through the day and evening.

If the drawee of a check or draft has changed his residence, the holder must use due or reasonable diligence to find him.

If one who holds a check as pay ee or otherwise transfers it to an other, he has a right to insist that the check be presented that day, or at fartherest, on the day following.

If the time of payment of a note is not inserted, it is payable on demand.

The time of payment of a note must not depend upon a contingency. The promise must be absolute.

An endorsee has a right of ac-If a note is lost or stolen it does tion against all whose names were on the bill when he received it.

The loss of a bill or note is not sufficient excuse for not giving notice of protest.

If two or more persons as partners are jointly liable on a note or bill, due notice to one of them is sufficient.

If a note or bill is transferred as security, or even as payment of a pre-existing debt, the debt revives if the bill or note be dishouored.

An endorsement may be written on the face or back.

An endorser may prevent his own liability to be sued by writing "without recourse," or similar words.

All claims which do not rest upon a seal or judgement must be sued within 6 years from the time when they arise.

Part payment of a debt which has passed the time of statuory limitation revives the whole debt, and the claim holds good for another period of 6 years from the date of such partial payment.

The verbal promise to pay, made County. without conditions, is generally held sufficient to revive a claim otherwise shut out by the law of limitation.
