The Methodist Episcopal Missionary society has appropriated \$11,500 for Spanish missions and \$2,000 for Spanish schools in New Mexico for the coming year.

By the death of Vice President Hobart Secretary Hay becomes heir in waiting, so to speak, to the White House, and Senator William P. Frye to the presidency of the Senate.

Great Britain is meeting with much stronger opposition than was expected, and the Boers are commanding the respect of the world for their bravery in defending their homes.

The American army in the Philippines has twelve Colt automatic guns, thirty-three Gatling guns, twenty-one two-pounder mountain guns, twenty-two twelve-pounder mountain guns and twelve Sims-Dudley dynamite guns.

An intimation that the Pullman Palace Car Company is planning to buy and remodel the old Union Pacific shops in Denver is fully confirmed by Union Pacific officials. President Burt, being questioned upon the subject, admits the fact and says it will be a big plant when fully installed.

But the fear is expressed in Washington that Roberts will take his seat and hold it during the term for which he was elected.
