Articles of Incorporation of the

Arizona Sanatorium And **Touring Company**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of Arizona, and for that purpose do adopt the following charter:

Article I.

The name of this corporation shall be the Arisona Sanatorium and Touring Company. Article II.

This Company shall keep an office at Holbrook, Arisona, and may keep other principal offices and places of business at the city of Los Angeles, State of California, at which place or places all incorporators', stockholders', and directors' meetings may be held, and all corporate business may be trans-

Article III.

The Amount of the capital stock of this Corporation shall be One Hundred and Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000) divided into twenty-five thousand (25,000) shares of the par value of Five Dollars (\$5.06) each. and said Capital stock shall be paid up at the day of issuance, or at such time as the Board of Directors may designate, in money, property, labor, or any other vuluable right or thing, and the judgement of the Board of Directors or Managing Officers as to the value thereof shall be conclusive.

Article IV The general nature of the business in which this corporation shall engage is as follows, towit:

That the purposes for which it is formed (a) The ocquisition, furnishing, and oper-

ating of hospitals; the erection and furnishing of tents.

(b) The employment of all necessary help and labor.

(c) The purchase of horses, mules, vehicles or other means of transportation and maintenance of same.

(d) The raising of live stock and farm pro-

(e) The erection and maintenance of telephone lines and switch-boards, or other means of communication.

(f) The building of reservoirs and development of water supply.

(g) The maintenance of branch offices at such towns and places as may be decided up-

(h) The organization and conducting of touring parties to places of interest in the United States and Mexico.

The distribution of advertising matter (j) To purchase or otherwis acquire, hold. own, sell, assign, transfer, invest, trade, own, sen, assign, classic and deal with, pledge, hypothedate, deal in and deal with, goods, wares, and merchandise, and personal property of every class and description.

[k] To purchase or otherwise acquire, to hold, own, sell, convey, lease, bond, mort-gage, or otherwise dispose of, without limit as to quantity, within the state of Arizona and elsewhere, real estate and real property, and any interests and rights therein.

(l) To purchase, lease, hire, exchange, or otherwise acquire any and all rights, privi-leges, permits, or franchises, suitable or convenient for any of the purposes of its busi-

[m] To hold, purchase, or otherwise acquire and to sell the capital stock of this corporation.

[n] To acquire, hold and sell stocks and bonds of other corporations.

[o] To make and enter into contracts of every kind, including leases, with any indi-

vidual firm, association or corporation.
[p] The transaction of all busness which may hereafter arise not specified above.

Article V. The affairs of this corporation shall be conducted by a Board of not less than five [5] nor more than seven [7] Directors, who shall e elected on the second Tuesday in January of each year as the By-Laws shall provide.

Article VI. The highest amount of liability that this corporation shall subject itself at any one time shall not exceed Fifty Thousand (50,-000:00) Dollar.

Article VII

This Corporation is formed to endure for twenty-five [25] years after its articles are duly executed, but its charter rights may be renewed-before its charter expires-from time to time, for periods not exceeding twenty-five years at a time, perpetually

Article VIII The private property of the stockholders of this Corporation shall be and is hereb made forever exempt from all liability for its debts or obligations.

Article IX. The capital stock of this corporation shall be and is made forever non-assessable by this Corporation for any purpose.


