But few children are absent on on the whole is fine, the children are neat and tidy and clean their teeth daily. At the White Oaks, Ragenton and Parsons schools, the same good condition of school and pupils exists. At Rabenton a little girl was found in need of treatment for a deformity, whom the County may be in a position to help, shortly. On the whole, the County schools are in good condition, the teachers kind and attentive. The defections mentioned are of no larger percent-age than found in other counties.
