"A Star Out of Jacob."

In the time of the reign of Hadrian, about A. D. 130, a Jew appeared among the peopl of Palestine claiming to be a messiah-the "star out of Jacob"which Balas n predicted in his prophecy. (See Numbers xxiv, 17.) This Jewish messial's name was Simeon Bar-Cocheba, which latter name in the Hebrew language means "son of a star." This individual who so blatently proclaimed himself to be of divine origin took Jerusalem by storm (A. D. 132) and actually commenced the rebuilding of the temple. He took the government in hand and issued coins and performed many other public offices. One of these coins, now in the British museum, has an enlarged star upon one side and upon the other a Hebrew legend meaning "The Deliverer of Jerusalem." The Jews, it is said. lost 600,000 men defending this messiah at the time when the Roman government attempted to put down the popular delusion. In Roman history Bar-Cocheba is known as "Coziba of Barchocheba." The enemies of the "son of a star" changed his name to "Bar-Cozeba," which in the Hebrew means "son of a lie."

Section 32. The Governor, the Committee, the Treasurer, the Attorney General and the Commissioner of Agriculture of the State of Florida, and their successors in office, are hereby constituted and designated as a board of drainage commissioners, and are hereby authorized and empowered to establish a system of canals, drains, levees, dikes and reservoirs of such dimension and depths, as in the judgment of said board of drainage commissioners is deemed advisable, to drain and reclaim the swamp and overflowed lands within the State of Florida, or such parts or portions thereof as is deemed best by said board of drainage commissioners from time to time, and to provide for the frigation of the lands reclaimed, and to maintain such canals, drains, levees, dikes, and reservoirs in such manner as will be most advantageous to the territory so drained, the State of Florida, its inhabitants and the commerce thereof. erritory so drained, the State of Florida, its in-

Section 33. That the board of drainage commissioners are hereby authorized and empowered to establish drainage districts and fix the boundries thereof in the State of Florida.
