Not a Black Eelipse.
This yeer the moon does not enter so there will not be a bleck eclipse. The mon, however, will be lis the ahadow of the earth, for over an hour
and practically the only light from the heavens will be that of the stars.
The reason why the moon will be Invialble is the influence of the sun's raye at the edge of illuminated hemispheres of our planet and throws on the moon a faint glow, gen
erally of a red copper hue. It result erally of a red copper hue. It results from the absorption in our atmos-
phere of the green, blue and violet phere of the green, blue and vioied
rays in the sun's light while the red rays pass through it. It is much the same as the sunset glow, though inAnitely more falint.
As the phenomenon of the ecllpse develops, the chlldren will be able to see for themselves the truth of the
statement they learned from their geographles.

## Eelippee of the Sun.

An eellpee of the sun will be wit nessed a fortnight later, on Thursday, June 17th, shortly before sunset. The
