## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE MEADOW RESERVOIR IRRIGATION COMPANY.

Know all men by these presents: That we, the undersigned, form a corporation, and by virtue of the laws of the Territory of Arizona, set forth the following Articles of Incorporation, to-wit:

### FIRST.

The names of the incorporators are John H. Plumb, Isaac Isaacson and E. J. Whiting. The name of the corporation is the Meadow Reservoir Irrigation Company, and its principal place for the transaction of business is in the town of St. Johns, County of Apache, Territory of Arizona.

### SECOND.

The general nature of the business to be transacted is to construct and repair dams, reservoirs, ditches, watergates, sluices and all other necessary means or constructions wherever located or situated in said Apache county for impounding, storing, preserving, conveying and distributing water for irrigation and domestic purposes and to collect pay from all persons using water so distributed at such rates as its Board of Directors may deem to be just, and generally to do all things lawful to be done in relation to
