**JOINT STATE-
HOOD MEETING**

HON. C. F. AINSWORTH
Addressed A Large Audience
In the Academy, Monday Eve

General Ainsworth came the 8th inst. and a large crowd of people were on hands to hear "the other side." The gathering was large and enthusiastic. So much had been said by former speakers against jointure that people were anxious to "here both sides" before election.

Gen. Ainsworth spoke for two and a half hours; everybody listened with intense interest. He stated facts and had the records to prove what he said. He made no appeal to prejudices; he "hewed to the line." He was repeatedly cheered. He showed without doubt that the corporations, from a business man's and bona fide resident's standpoint, had the people of Arizona and New Mexico by the neck, under present governmental arrangements. He showed why the real citizens were safe in accepting joint statehood.

Gen. Ainsworth is the candidate on the Statehood Party's ticket for delegate to congress; but he did not even refer to the fact. Hon. Alfred Ruiz, who presided at the meeting, announced at the close of the address that Gen. Ainsworth held his candidacy secondary to that of the question of jointure, and wished the people to vote for jointure. Gen. Ainsworth firmly declared, in private conversation, that he had very strong reasons to believe that he would be Arizona's next delegate to congress; he will appreciate the votes of the people.
