THE seal skin of the future will be beyond the reach of all but very wealthy people. Late investigations by skilled observers show that the seals of the Alaskan waters have been almost exterminated within the past few years. The total catch this year by licensed American sealers was only 21,000 last year it was 100,000. The Canadian poachers have furthered the work of destruction by carrying off 18,165 pelts from Behring Sea this year.
