Nels Monson was down from Reliance Saturday, and called for a little visit with the Argus-Leader man. Nels came to Lyman county in 1893, the year when it was so dry that the early settlers almost lost track of the meaning of the word rain or water. There were a few others who came that same year but the most of them are gone, but Nels is a stayer and he is not the least bit sorry he stayed either, for he thinks he has done as well here as he could have done anywhere else, considering what he had to start with—an old team of horses, wagon and harness—the entire outfit not worth a hundred dollars. But he filed on his homestead just the same and worked and pluggled along as best he could, buying a cow or a calf or a horse just as his pile would permit, and today he has as good a half section of land as there is in the county with about fifty head of stock on it, a few pigs and chickens, and he farms about fifty acres of the land. The remainder of the place is given over to pasture, and the beauty of it is, that it is all his and no one has a mortgage on anything he has. He is able to sit by his own fireside with contentment on his face and say to the weather, "Come as you will, I am here ahead of you and ready for your blusters." Nels has never allowed himself to go wild over the boom which has been floating over the county so briskly the past few years, and it is for this that he now has his head above water. That is the class of men that has prospered most in this country and who will continue to prosper in the future. —Oscoma Argus-Leader.
