M. Copy of said proposed rules have been filed with the Division of Statutory Research and Drafting. To amend Regulation No. 4 to read as follows:

That it shall be lawful to hunt deer statewide, from December 15 - January 5, inclusive. That it shall be unlawful to kill deer of less than seventy-five pounds live weight.

To amend Regulation No. 99 to read as follows:

That it shall be unlawful to hunt deer of either sex with bow and arrow from October 15 to November 1, dates inclusive, except where there is a closed general hunting season on deer. Provided, however, it shall be unlawful to use a crossbow or poison arrows at any time for the purpose of hunting wild birds and wild animals.

To amend Regulation No. 1 to read as follows:

That the season for hunting deer shall begin the third Monday in November and close January 5 statewide, with the following exceptions:

(a) In the counties west of the Blue Ridge Mountains, in Patrick County and in that section of Amherst County west of route No. 29 and in Nelson County west of route 151, deer may be hunted from the third Monday in November for six consecutive hunting days only, and, in that section of Giles County west of New River deer may be hunted only for two days, November 22 and 23.

(b) It shall be unlawful to hunt deer at any time in the counties of Arlington, Bedford, Buchanan, Dickenson, Fairfax in that section closed to all hunting, Floyd, Franklin, Henry, Loudoun, Montgomery, Northampton, Pittsylvania, Pulaski in that section north of New River, and Wythe north of Highway No. 11.

(c) It shall be unlawful to hunt deer with dogs in Patrick County, in Nelson County in that section west of Route No. 151 and in Amherst County in that section lying west of Route No. 29. BAG LIMITS: The lawful bag limit for deer shall be one buck a season, with the following exceptions:

(a) Any one deer may be taken on the last two days of the open season in Alleghany, Augusta, Bath, Botetourt, Clarke, Craig, Frederick, Giles in that section east of New River, Highland, Page, Roanoke, Rockbridge, Rockingham, Shenandoah and Warren Counties.

(b) Any one deer may be taken on the last day of the open season in Carroll, Grayson, Lee, Scott, Smyth south of highway No. 11, Washington south of highway No. 11, Wise, and Wythe south of highway No. 11.

To amend Regulation No. 1 to read as follows:
