

## A CIGARETTE LICENSE.

Chicago Dealers Will Have to Pay \$100 a Year.

CHICAGO, March 3.—The city council by a unanimous vote has passed an ordinance requiring every dealer in cigarettes in Chicago to pay an annual license of \$100 to the city treasury. The law passed says that cigarettes cannot be sold within 200 feet of a school. All sold by licensed dealers must have been inspected by the commissioner of health and receive his approval as to their purity. No cigarette can be sold which contains opium, morphine, gypsum or other poisonous matter. The down town dealers in the paper sticks say they will not feel the effects of the license much, but in the suburbs the effect of the ordinance will be to practically prohibit the sale. Mayor Swift will sign the ordinance which goes into effect immediately.

The women's clubs have taken great interest in the cigarette ordinance, because it was at least a step in the direction of stopping the use of tobacco by school boys.

Mrs. Penoyer L. Sherman, vice president of the Chicago Woman's club, and ex-chairman of the reform committee, says:

"While the ordinance will not stop the sale of cigarettes, its general effect will be good in several ways. It will close out the small dealers and thus lessen the temptation of the boys."

## BUILDINGS WRECKED.

Portion of Wyoming, Pa., Drops a Distance of Twenty-five Feet.

WILKESBARRE, Pa., March 3.—An extensive cavern occurred in the town of Wyoming in the main workings of the Schooley mine, 600 feet underneath the town. A loud report was heard and houses shook on their foundations. An investigation showed that the surface had caved in in some places a distance of 25 feet. The area affected is about 150 yards long and 200 yards wide. The postoffice is almost a complete wreck, and other buildings, including three dwellings, sank a distance of 20 feet. The cause is said to be a lack of sufficient props for the roof.

There were 74 men in the mine at the time. Some of them had narrow escapes. Ninety-six males were entombed in the mine stable and it is doubtful if they will be taken out alive.

## Long Has Accepted.

BOSTON, March 3.—Ex-Governor John D. Long of Massachusetts has announced that he has accepted the navy portfolio in President McKinley's cabinet.

## BRIEF BITS OF NEWS.

The Rev. George S. Mallory, editor of The Churchman, died at New York Tuesday, aged 55.

The Missouri house, by a vote of 75 to 47, passed a bill to make railroad fares in that state 2 cents per mile.

Over 2,000,000 pounds of naphtha have been destroyed by fire at Taganrog, in the naphtha springs district in Russia.

The state department has been informed that diplomatic relations between Venezuela and Great Britain, which were interrupted some years ago, have been restored.

The New York court of appeals has decided that the Percy-Gray racing law is constitutional, and that the methods of book-making allowed by the racing commissioners are in accordance with the law.

## THE BICYCLE CRAZE.

It Appears to Have Struck Germany With Great Force.

WASHINGTON, March 3.—Germany's bicycle business in 1897 is to beat all previous records, says United States Consul Monaghan at Chemnitz, in a report to the state department. Great preparations are being made to meet enormous demands. Many of the factories that failed last year to meet demands, have doubled their capacity and output. Many of the larger concerns will deliver from 20,000 to 40,000 wheels. One company near Nuremberg is shipping 1,000 wheels each week. The works have already taken orders for their full capacity this year, yet orders continue to flow in. The consul says there is a big business to be done by any American company that will place a neat light and substantial wheel on the German market at from \$50 to \$75—a \$100 wheel cannot be sold.

## MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS.

Various Iowa Cities Choose Their Officers.

DES MOINES, Ia., March 3.—Municipal elections were held in a number of Iowa cities during the day. Party lines were not closely drawn, the issues being entirely of a local nature.

All cities of 2,000 population and over held elections except Des Moines and the special charter cities. Full city tickets and one-half membership of the city councils were elected in nearly every instance.

At Ottumwa a fight was made by the Democrats for the restriction of saloon licenses. The entire Democratic ticket was carried.

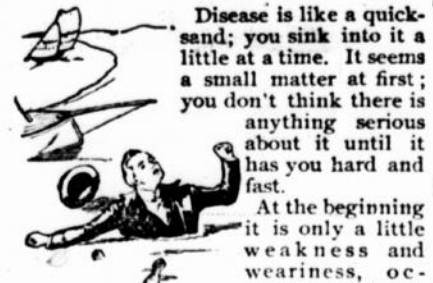
At Cedar Rapids a Republican mayor was elected.

At Creston Niemeyer (Dem.) was elected mayor by a plurality of 75.
