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STATE NEWS

Aberdeen.—Thirty-seven head of Shorthorn cattle sold at the second annual sale of the South Dakota Shorthorn Breeders' association here for \$9,805 or an average of \$265 a head. The top was a heifer consigned by Jackson & White of Hurley, which sold for \$1,000 to Fred Lee of Britton.

Beresford.—The recent electrical storm resulted in the burning of the barn on the Frank Dubrall place about three miles southeast of town, together with six horses and the destruction of about 40 tons of feed that Mr. Dubrall had stored to furnish his neighbors during the summer.

Pierre.—The first case under the workmen's compensation law of this state has been before the supreme court for consideration, and the award by the industrial department of \$1,650 to Frank Day and Pearl Day as dependents of Van Day, has been affirmed. The law had not in any former case been before the supreme court.

Pierre.—More than 1,000 delegates are expected to attend the annual meeting of the grand lodge of the Masonic order to be held at Pierre on June 8 and 9. The thirty-second annual session of the Order of Eastern Star will be held in conjunction with the Masonic convention and several hundred women are expected to attend.

Pierre.—The annual session of the legislature will be asked to take action to encourage home building in the towns and cities of South Dakota. To the present, such legislation has been enacted only toward upbuilding of farm homes, and the city dweller has not been included in the privilege of borrowing public funds to assist him in the development of his home property.

Aberdeen.—The supreme court has affirmed the verdict of the circuit court for Brown county in favor of the plaintiff in the case of Lowary vs. Lowary, an action for the recovery of \$5,000 damages alleged to have been sustained by the plaintiff in crop losses when his brother, the defendant refused to allow him to go onto a quarter of land, which had been leased, to harvest his crop. The plaintiff secured a verdict of \$2,500. During the trial of the case it was testified that the brother owning the land threatened to shoot the other if he tried to harvest the crop.

Philip.—Some effective prairie dog eradication work is being done in this county under farm bureau auspices. A prairie dog squad of four men has been organized. They have an auto truck covered with canvas and a trailer in which they carry cooking equipment and food. They use the empty truck to travel to and from dog towns, cleaning up dogs on one side of the camp, then other and then check the results and re-poison if necessary before leaving the township.
