

THE SULLY COUNTY WATCHMAN.

A DISPATCH from Ellendale, Dakota, says that a very singular and startling discovery, consisting of finding the skeletons of twenty-three men and about the same number of horses, was made in the northwestern part of Dickey county a few days since by a party of explorers. The skeletons were found in a valley in that singular range of hills extending from near Fort Pierre to the British line near the head of Moose river. Among the skeletons were found brass cavalry buttons, shoes and other effects of mounted men, but no guns or implements of war. There were also some shoes remaining on the bones of the horses' feet. This country has been a fruitful field of death, as evidenced by the many skeletons found in other places, most of which came from the raid made in Minnesota in '63, and were a part of the prisoners carried away by the retreating Indians.
