San Francisco, Jan. 22.—The California Club has begun an active campaign against impure milk. Mrs. Arthur W. Cornwall and Minora Kibbe, both members of the club's pure milk committee, accompanied by Dr. George Melody, personally invaded two large dairies on the south side of the city, and made a thorough examination of their sanitary and health conditions.

WILL BUILD THEIR BRIDGE

Will Build New Bridge.

Manager Page, of the Portland General Electric, in speaking to a Journal reporter yesterday of the possibility of the company building a bridge across Mill creek, on North Commercial street, said: "If it is the council's wish we will certainly move from the concrete bridge immediately. We have always been on the side of right in all matters, and, although we have been to quite an expense owing to placing our rails on the bridge, and the maintenance of the structure, still we are willing to abide by the decision of the council without fighting the matter. As to building a new bridge," he continued, "the company will probably construct a bridge as soon as possible, but, of course, it will be some time before a structure could be completed. If we build on the east side of the present bridge it would be necessary to obtain a private right of way on the north bank of Mill creek, which up to this date we have been unable to obtain. On the west side of the concrete structure there is only a space of 15 feet where the present bridge is the narrowest, and at the ends where the wings spread to the banks we could not make the turn on the north bank without driving piles in the gravel wing, which might endanger the embankment. At least I do not think the company will care to take the chances without first being released by the city from any damage which might occur. If we are put off the bridge of course it will mean that traffic must stop north of Mill creek until the bridge can be built."

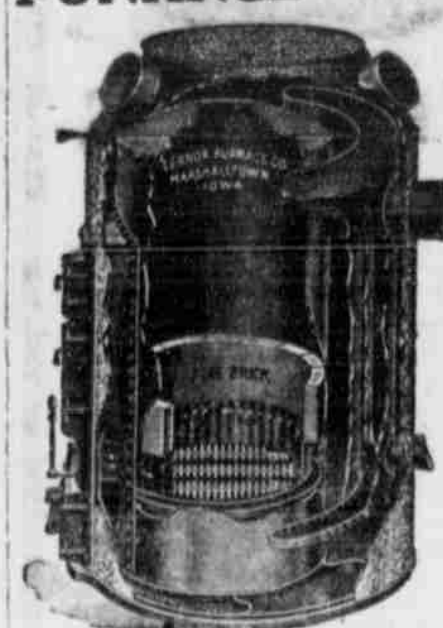
